For our buyers to successfully re-manufacture recycled items such as cardboard, plastic drums and bulk bags these items must meet certain specifications. For this reason, it is important to speak with us about your items' suitability for recycling and our requirements as listed below.

Material requirements

Correct material	Phone to check item is recyclable – photo and sample may be required
Pre-check	Phone pre-delivery and load is inspected on site before drop-off
Clean and dry	No contents, rinse and drain
Contaminants removed	Remove materials different from the main item e.g. wires or screws on bumper bars, plastic chair metal legs, water-cooler bottle handle and lid. No soil or plant material
Colour sorted	Required for some items
Bulk load	Ute or truck loads
Packing method	e.g. rolled up, bagged, loose or baled
Material size	Size limits or items cut to specified size e.g. water tanks

What we can recycle

Currently we can recycle bulk loads of the following materials profitably if they meet our requirements. Eligible items change with market demand.

Plastics

Polyethylene Terephthalate (PET - No.1)
 High Density Polyethylene (HDPE - No.2)
 Low Density Polyethylene (LDPE - No.4)
 Polypropylene (PP - No.5)
 Polycarbonate (PC - No.7)

E-waste

Desktops, laptops, flatscreens, printers, photocopiers, mobile phones

Paper and cardboard

Aluminum and steel

Glass
